

VALET PARKING FOR SENIORS & PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

We want to be sure that seniors and persons with disabilities who drive to Temple Sinai for the High Holy Days do not have to worry about long and difficult walks from parking far away. We hope our new Courtesy Valet Parking program will make access to services easier and encourage more people with disabilities to attend.

Who is Eligible?

Persons who have a "Persons with Disability Parking Placard" or Disability License Plate and who drive themselves and/or their family.

How Does It Work?

1. Complete this form and return it to Temple Sinai in the enclosed envelope by Fri., Sept. 20.
2. We will mail you a COURTESY VALET PARKING PERMIT to show to D&P Valet, who will be stationed at the Kittanning Way entrance of Temple Sinai. (*Show the permit to D&P Valet each time you attend one of the applicable services.**)
3. Due to logistics and crowds, please note there could be a wait of up to 10 minutes to receive your car.
